- 24 Behold, vengeance cometh speedily upon the inhabitants of the earth, a day of wrath, a day of burning, a day of desolation, of weeping, of mourning, and of lamentation; and as a whirlwind it shall come upon all the face of the earth, saith the Lord.
- 25 And upon my house shall it begin, and from my house shall it go forth, saith the Lord; (The USA gets NUKED 1st.)
- 26 First among those among you, saith the Lord, who have professed to know my name and have not known me, and have blasphemed against me in the midst of my house, saith the Lord. DC 112:24-26
- 30 Fear not thine enemies, for they are in mine hands and I will do my pleasure with them. 31 My people must be tried in all things, that they may be prepared to receive the glory that I have for them, even the glory of Zion; and he that will not bear chastisement is not worthy of my kingdom.
- 32 Let him that is ignorant learn wisdom by humbling himself and calling upon the Lord his God, that his eyes may be opened that he may see, and his ears opened that he may hear; 33 For my Spirit is sent forth into the world to enlighten the humble and contrite, and to the condemnation of the ungodly. 34 Thy brethren have rejected you and your testimony, even the nation that has driven you out;
- 35 And now cometh the day of their calamity, even the days of sorrow, like a woman that is taken in travail: and their sorrow shall be great unless they speedily repent, yea, very speedily.
- 36 For they killed the prophets, and them that were sent unto them; and they have shed innocent blood, which crieth from the ground against them.
- 37 Therefore, marvel not at these things, for we are not yet pure; DC 136:30-37

# The Kingdom of God from Modern Revelation

April 6, 1844 The Diaries and Journals of Joseph Smith page 463.

## Volume 3

History Of The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints 7:382 we read:

“We are asked, **IS THE CHURCH OF GOD, and THE KINGDOM OF GOD THE SAME organization?** And we are informed that some of the brethren hold that **THEY ARE SEPARATE. THIS IS THE CORRECT VIEW TO TAKE.**  
**THE KINGDOM OF GOD is a SEPARATE organization from the Church of God.**

On this point **THE PROPHET JOSEPH GAVE AN EXAMPLE.** which he asked the younger elders who were present to always remember. (Tell me how the LDS Authorities “TODAY” can forget Joseph Smiths instructions?) It was to the effect **that men might be chosen to officiate as members of THE KINGDOM OF GOD who had NO standing in the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-Day Saints.”**

- 1 The rise of the Church of Christ in these last days, being one thousand eight hundred and thirty years since the coming of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ in the flesh, it being regularly organized and established agreeable to the laws of our country, by the will and commandments of God, in the fourth month, and on the sixth day of the month which is called April—
- 2 Which commandments were given to Joseph Smith, Jun., who was called of God, and ordained an apostle of Jesus Christ, to be the first elder of this church;
- 3 And to Oliver Cowdery, who was also called of God, an apostle of Jesus Christ, to be the second elder of this church, and ordained under his hand:
- 3 And this according to the grace of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ, to whom be all glory, both now and forever. Amen. Doctrine and Covenants 20:1-4 (Hereafter DC)
- 1 Verily I say unto you, my friends, I give unto you counsel, and a commandment, concerning all the properties which belong to the order which I commanded to be organized and established, to be a united order, and an everlasting order for the benefit of

- 16 And this shall be your business and mission in all your lives, to preside in council, and set in order all the affairs of this church and kingdom. DC 90:2-3,16
- 1 Verily, thus saith the Lord: It shall come to pass that every soul who forsaketh his sins and cometh unto me, and calleth on my name, and obeyeth my voice, and keepeth my commandments, shall see my face and know that I am; 27 And no man receiveth a fulness unless he keepeth his commandments.
- 28 He that keepeth his commandments receiveth truth and light, until he is glorified in truth and knoweth all things. DC 93:1,27-28
- 5 But behold, verily I say unto you, that there are many who have been ordained among you, whom I have called but few of them are chosen.
- 6 They who are not chosen have sinned a very grievous sin, in that they are walking in darkness at noon-day. DC 95:5-6 (Do NOT READ commands)
- 14 That they may be perfected in the understanding of their ministry, in theory, in principle, and in doctrine, in all things pertaining to the kingdom of God on the earth, the keys of which kingdom have been conferred upon you.
- 15 And inasmuch as my people build a house unto me in the name of the Lord, and do not suffer any unclean thing to come into it, that it be not defiled, my glory shall rest upon it;
- 16 Yea, and my presence shall be there, for I will come into it, and all the pure in heart that shall come into it shall see God.
- 17 But if it be defiled I will not come into it, and my glory shall not be there; for I will not come into unholy temples. (See Zechariah 14:21) 18 And, now, behold, if Zion do these things she shall prosper, and spread herself and become very glorious, very great, and very terrible. DC 97:14-18
- 38 And seek the face of the Lord always, that in patience ye may possess your souls, and ye shall have eternal life.
- 39 When men are called unto mine everlasting gospel, and covenant with an everlasting covenant, they are accounted as the salt of the earth and the savor of men;
- 40 They are called to be the savor of men; therefore, if that salt of the earth lose its savor, behold, it is thenceforth good for nothing only to be cast out and trodden under the feet of men. (Millions of LDS will walk on Leaders ashes in Fallout)
- 41 Behold, here is wisdom concerning the children of Zion, even many, but not all; they were found transgressors, therefore they must needs be chastened DC 101:38-41
- 18 The power and authority of the higher, or Melchizedek

- my church, and for the salvation of men until I come—
- 2 With promise immutable and unchangeable, that inasmuch as those whom I commanded were faithful they should be blessed with a multiplicity of blessings;
- 3 But inasmuch as they were not faithful they were nigh unto cursing. DC 104:1-3
- 1 Verily thus saith the Lord unto you, my servant Joseph Smith, Jun., and also my servant Sidney Rigdon, and also my servant Hyrum Smith, and your counselors who are and shall be appointed hereafter;
- 2 And also unto you, my servant Edward Partridge, and his counselors;
- 3 And also unto my faithful servants who are of the high council of my church in Zion, for thus it shall be called, and unto all the elders and people of my Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, scattered abroad in all the world;
- 4 For thus shall my church be called in the last days, even The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints.
- 5 Verily I say unto you all: Arise and shine forth, that thy light may be a standard for the nations; DC 115:1-5 (This on April 26, 1838)
- 1 Verily, thus saith the Lord, I require all their surplus property to be put into the hands of the bishop of my church in Zion,
- 2 For the building of mine house, and for the laying of the foundation of Zion and for the priesthood, and for the debts of the Presidency of my Church.
- 3 And this shall be the beginning of the tithing of my people.
- 4 And after that, those who have thus been tithed shall pay one-tenth of all their interest annually; and this shall be a standing law unto them forever, for my holy priesthood, saith the Lord.
- 5 Verily I say unto you, it shall come to pass that all those who gather unto the land of Zion shall be tithed of their surplus properties, and shall observe this law, or they shall not be found worthy to abide among you.
- 6 And I say unto you, if my people observe not this law, to keep it holy, and by this law sanctify the land of Zion unto me, that my statutes and my judgments may be kept thereon, that it may be most holy, behold, verily I say unto you, it shall NOT be a land of Zion unto you.
- 7 And this shall be an ensample unto all the stakes of Zion. Even so. Amen. DC 119:1-7 (This on July 8, 1838)
- 28 And when the times of the gentiles is come in, a light shall break forth among them that sit in darkness, and it shall be the

- 38 For it shall come to pass that the inhabitants of Zion shall judge all things pertaining to Zion.
- 39 And liars and hypocrites shall be proved by them, and they who are not apostles and prophets shall be known.
- 40 And even the bishop, who is a judge, and his counselors, if they are not faithful in their stewardships shall be condemned, and others shall be planted in their stead. DC 64:38-40
- 5 Call upon the Lord, that his kingdom may go forth upon the earth, that the inhabitants thereof may receive it, and be prepared for the days to come, in the which the Son of Man shall come down in heaven, clothed in the brightness of his glory, to meet the kingdom of God which is set up on the earth.
- 6 Wherefore, may the kingdom of God go forth, that the kingdom of heaven may come, that thou, O God, mayest be glorified in heaven so on earth, that thine enemies may be subdued: for thine is the honor, power and glory, forever and ever. Amen. DC 65:5-6
- 6 Wherefore, a commandment I give unto them, that they shall not give these things unto the church, neither unto the world;
- 7 Nevertheless, inasmuch as they receive more than is needful for their necessities and their wants, it shall be given into my storehouse;
- 8 And the benefits shall be consecrated unto the inhabitants of Zion, and unto their generations, inasmuch as they become heirs according to the laws of the kingdom. DC 70:6-8
- 6 And the anger of God kindleth against the inhabitants of the earth; and none doeth good, for all have gone out of the way.
- 7 And now, verily I say unto you, I, the Lord, will not lay any sin to your charge; go your ways and sin no more; but unto that soul who sinneth shall the former sins return, saith the Lord your God. DC 82:6-7
- 68 Therefore, sanctify yourselves that your minds become single to God, and the days will come that you shall see him; for he will unveil his face unto you, and it shall be in his own time, and in his own way, and according to his own will. DC 88:68
- 2 Therefore, thou art blessed from henceforth that bear the keys of the kingdom given unto you; which kingdom is coming forth for the last time.
- 3 Verily I say unto you, the keys of this kingdom shall never be taken from you, while thou art in the world, neither in the world to come;

- 4 Yea, whosoever will thrust in his sickle and reap, the same is called of God.
- 5 Therefore, if you will ask of me you shall receive; if you will knock it shall be opened unto you.
- 6 Now, as you have asked, behold, I say unto you, keep my commandments, and seek to bring forth and establish the cause of Zion;
- 7 Seek not for riches but for wisdom, and behold, the mysteries of God shall be unfolded unto you, and then shall you be made rich. Behold, he that hath eternal life is rich. DC 6:3-7
- 3 Behold, the field is white already to harvest; therefore, whose desireth to reap let him thrust in his sickle with his might, and reap while the day lasts, that he may treasure up for his soul everlasting salvation in the kingdom of God.
- 6 Now, as you have asked, behold, I say unto you, keep my commandments, and seek to bring forth and establish the cause of Zion.
- 7 Seek not for riches but for wisdom; and, behold, the mysteries of God shall be unfolded unto you, and then shall you be made rich. Behold, he that hath eternal life is rich.

- 4 Verily, I say unto you that ye are chosen out of the world to declare my gospel with the sound of rejoicing, as with the voice of a trumpet.
- 5 Lift up your hearts and be glad, for I am in your midst, and am your advocate with the Father; and it is his good will to give you the kingdom. DC 29:4-5
- 8 But the day soon cometh that ye shall see me, and know that I am; for the veil of darkness shall soon be rent, and he that is not purified shall not abide the day.
- 9 Wherefore, gird up your loins and be prepared. Behold, the kingdom is yours, and the enemy shall not overcome. DC 38:8,9
- 64 And even now, let him that goeth to the east teach them that shall be converted to flee to the west, and this in consequence of that which is coming on the earth, and of secret combinations.
- 65 Behold, thou shalt observe all these things, and great shall be thy reward: for unto you it is given to know the mysteries of the kingdom, but unto the world it is not given to know them. (WHO warned you of War?)
- 66 Ye shall observe the laws which ye have received and be faithful. DC 42:64-66
- 28 And when the times of the Gentiles is come in, a light shall break forth among them that sit in darkness, and it shall be the fulness of my gospel; (NOW)
- 29 But they receive it not; for they perceive not the light, and they turn their hearts from me because of the precepts of men.
- 30 And in that generation shall the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. (NOW)
- 31 And there shall be men standing in that generation, that shall not pass until they shall see an overflowing scourge; for a desolating sickness shall cover the land. DC 45:28-31 (Fallout around the World)
- 5 Thus saith the Lord; for I am God, and have sent mine Only Begotten Son into the world for the redemption of the world, and have decreed that he that receiveth him shall be saved, and he that receiveth him not shall be damned DC 49:5
- 23 But unto him that keepeth my commandments I will give the mysteries of my kingdom, and the same shall be in him a well of living water, springing up unto everlasting life.
- 62 For behold, verily I say, that many there be who are under this condemnation, who use the name of the Lord, and use it in vain, having not authority. 63 Wherefore, let the church repent of their sins, and I, the Lord, will own them; otherwise they shall be cut off. DC 63:23,62-63

- 3 Behold, the field is white already to harvest; therefore, whose desireth to reap let him thrust in his sickle with his might, and reap while the day lasts, that he may treasure up for his soul everlasting salvation in the kingdom of God.
- 7 And, if you keep my commandments and endure to the end you shall have eternal life, which gift is the greatest of all the gifts of God.
- 10 Wherefore, I must bring forth the fulness of my gospel from the Gentiles unto the house of Israel. DC 14:3,7,10
- 78 Wherefore, they are bodies terrestrial, and not bodies celestial, and differ in glory as the moon differs from the sun.
- 79 These are they who are not valiant in the testimony of Jesus; wherefore, they obtain not the crown over the kingdom of our God. DC 76:78,79
- 32 That the kingdoms of this world may be constrained to acknowledge that the kingdom of Zion is in very deed the kingdom of our God and his Christ; therefore, let us become subject unto her laws. DC 105:32
- 43 And now, after that you have received this, you must keep my commandments in all things;
- 44 And by your hands I will work a marvelous work among the children of men, unto the convincing of many of their sins, that they may come unto repentance, and that they may come unto the kingdom of my Father. DC 18:43,44
- 13 Unto whom I have committed the keys of my kingdom, and a dispensation of the gospel for the last times; and for the fulness of times, in the which I will gather together in one all things, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth;
- 14 And also with all those whom my Father hath given me out
